


# **AIR HOSE REEL INSTRUCTIONS**

# **Specifications:**

- -Hose reel is for compressed air use only, unit is rated for 200 psi, air hose is rated for 300 psi
- -Operation temperature between 0°F and I40°F.
- -Indoor use, do not mount outside exposed to the elements, or on a service truck.


### Installation:

- -Use a flexible hose connection between the air supply pipe and hose reel, do not hard plumb, damage to the swivel will result.
- -Assemble all NPT pipe thread connections with two wraps of teflon tape and then pipe sealant, to prevent thread galling
- -Best to add a shut off valve near the reel, to stop the flow of air if needed.
- -Reel can be mounted on ceiling, wall or floor. Mounting surface must be load bearing and have the ability to support the weight of the reel and constant pulling motion.
- -After mounting, rotate the guide arm to allow the hose to pull thru rollers with minimal bending.

# **AIR HOSE REEL INSTRUCTIONS**

# **Operation:**

- I. After mounting, pull the air hose slowly from the reel until you reach the desired length
- 2. Listen for a clicking sound as the pawl engages the stopping ring, slowly release hose until reel stops
- 3. To return hose on the reel, pull slowly, disengage the pawl and slowly return the hose on the reel DO NOT LET GO OF THE HOSE. DAMAGE TO THE REEL WILL OCCUR

### **Maintenance:**

- -Reel contains a high-tension spring assembly, to avoid injury remove all spring tension and air pressure before disassembly
- -To adjust spring tension, remove or add a single wrap of the hose on the spool, until desired tension is achieved
- -Reel and mechanisms do not require periodic lubrication, but keep the latching mechanism clean for proper engagement

## WARNINGS

- -Failure to mount hose reel to a structurally sound structure could result in injury or death
- -Always use EYE PROTECTION when using compressed air
- -DO NOT POINT compressed air at your body or any person
- -Pressurize system SLOWLY
- -TURN OFF air compressor when not in use
- -ALWAYS RELIEVE the system pressure when installing or performing maintenance
- -Systems must have a SAFETY RELIEF valve installed at the compressed air source to prevent over pressurization
